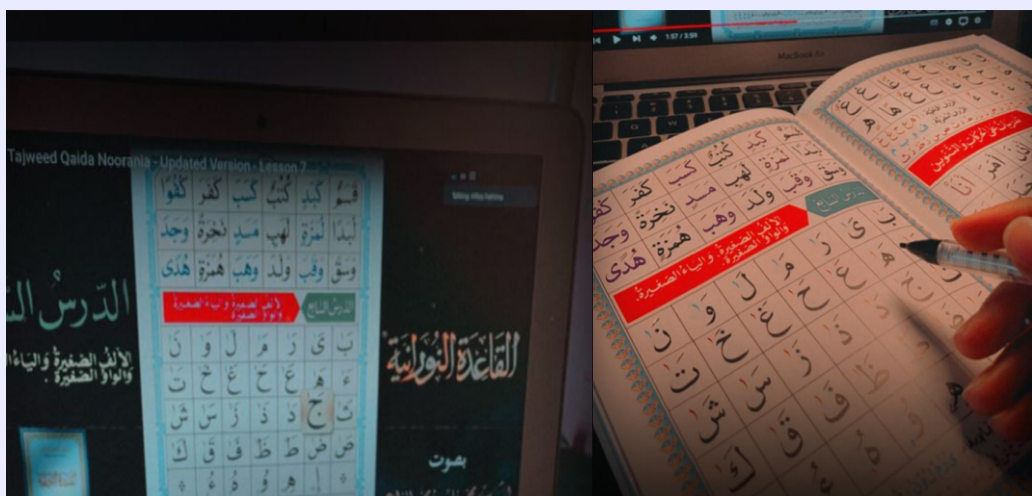

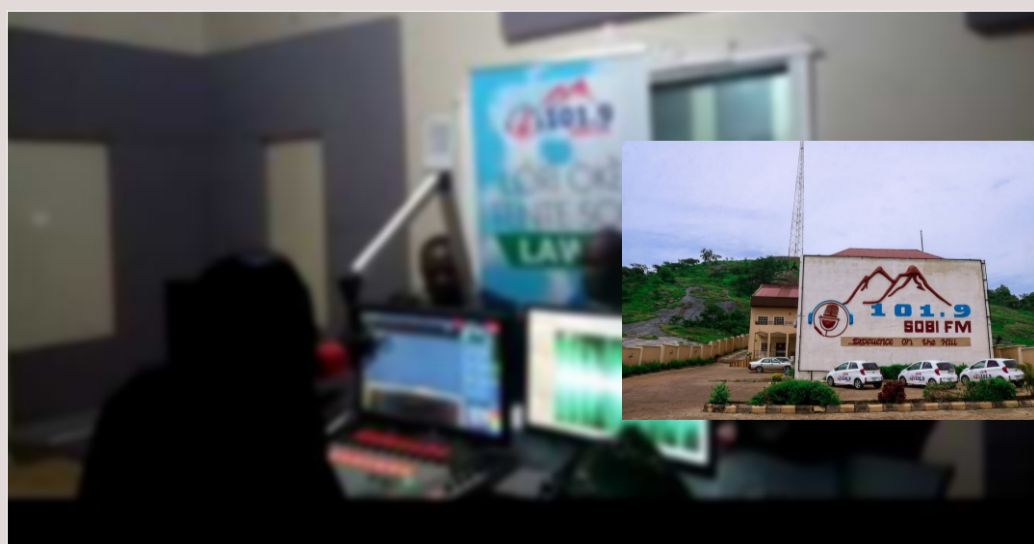
CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Ramaḍhān Radio Program:
